- Your United Way of Cayuga County has been serving the central region since 1922 when we opened as the Community Chest of Auburn
- 35 of the 36 United Way funded programs serve county central residents
- Towns that make up County Central are Aurelius, Fleming, Owasco, Sennett, Throop as well as the City of Auburn and the Village of Cayuga
- Of those turning to a United Way funded program, 82% live in the Auburn and Cayuga zip codes

Gifts to the United Way of Cayuga County support community resilience, youth opportunity, healthy communities, and financial security programs. Healthy Communities = nourished communities. With food insecurity on the rise, the need for feeding programs is growing. SS Peter & John Episcopal Soup Kitchen provides more than 36,000 meals a year and thanks to United Way funding they are able to increase their days of service from three to four.

Dear Neighbor:

As a kid, I was an active and proud Boy Scout, known today as **Scouting America**: **Longhouse Council**. Much of the foundation for my leadership skills and passion for community service were fostered through this program—which has been supported here in Cayuga County by community members, like you, since 1922. As I look ahead at all the things that my fellow Campaign Co-Chairs and I have planned for the season, I am reminded of a line from the Scout Oath: "To help other people at all times."

During the last funding cycle, more than 60% of Cayuga County residents turned to a United Way funded program—a number that continues to grow. This year, your United Way is supporting 28 nonprofits through 36 distinct programs addressing **Community Resilience**, **Youth Opportunity**, **Healthy Communities**, and **Financial Security**.

Will you make your United Way of Cayuga County gift today?

As a first responder, ensuring families have access to basic needs, like food, is important. In Cayuga County 36% of families struggle to survive, often facing the difficult choice of paying rent or buying groceries. With food insecurity on the rise, the United Way of Cayuga County welcomed two new Member Agencies to help feed our neighbors. SS Peter & John Episcopal Soup Kitchen can serve our community an additional day each week growing from three days to four. Safe and Warm, a program of the Harriet Tubman Liberation Foundation, has volunteers to prepare sandwiches that they distribute to underhoused neighbors every Friday.



For more than a century, your dollars have supported The Salvation Army. Did you know Auburn residents can utilize their Food Pantry, Soup Kitchen, Weekly Food Giveaway, and Monthly Fresh Food Giveaway programs? Learn more about feeding programs and the impact the Countywide Personal Care Drive has on our food pantries by scanning the QR code.

Food security is just one area where your United Way gifts provide support. Cayuga Counseling Services' newly funded program, **Strengthening Families**, increases

family bonding, improves problem solving skills, and decreases family conflicts through conversation over a family meal. During the last funding cycle, Catholic Charities of the Finger Lakes' **Emergency Energy Assistance** program kept utilities on for nearly 160 Auburn residents. Did you know that Westminster Manor Adult Home has a robust **Activities Program** to keep their senior residents engaged and active in the community? Of the Member Agencies, 17 are either headquartered or have a satellite office in the city of Auburn.
