- Your United Way of Cayuga County has been countywide since August 2, 1948
- 32 of the 36 United Way funded programs have the capacity to be countywide based on who is accessing the service
- * Towns that make up County North: Brutus, Cato, Conquest, Ira, Mentz, Montezuma, Sterling, & Victory
- Between 10 900 County North residents, in EACH of the 7 zip codes, accessed a United Way program

With food insecurity on the rise, the need for feeding programs is growing. Dear Neighbor:

As an active member of the Weedsport Association of Parents and Teachers and a local educator, I am grateful to the United Way for funding the Auburn YMCA-WEIU's After School Program in Weedsport as well as Port Byron, Cato, and Moravia. I am thankful that the United Way touches so many people and families in our community from educational resources to health and financial services. What a wonderful way to give to our community-to give back and support our neighbors across Cayuga County.

During the last funding cycle, more than 60% of Cayuga County residents turned to a United Way funded program—a number that continues to grow. This year, your United Way is supporting 28 nonprofits through 36 distinct programs addressing Community Resilience, Youth Opportunity, Healthy Communities, and Financial Security.

Will you make your United Way of Cayuga County gift today?

As a parent, ensuring my family has healthy meals and snacks is important. In Cayuga County 36% of families struggle to survive, often facing the difficult choice of paying rent or buying groceries. With food insecurity on the rise, the United Way of Cayuga County welcomed two new Member Agencies to help feed our neighbors. SS Peter & John Episcopal Soup Kitchen can serve our community an additional day each week growing from three days to four. Safe and Warm, a program of the Harriet Tubman Liberation Foundation, has volunteers to prepare sandwiches that they distribute to underhoused neighbors in Port Byron and Auburn every Friday.



Since 1922, your dollars have supported The Salvation Army. Did you know their Soup Kitchen, Weekly Food Giveaway, and Monthly Fresh Food Giveaway programs are open to all Cayuga County residents? Learn more about feeding programs and the impact the Countywide Personal Care Drive has on organizations like the Port Byron Food Pantry by scanning the QR code.

Food security is just one area where your United Way gifts provide support. County North neighbors turn to Literacy Volunteers of Cayuga County to improve their

communication skills. Did you know that your gifts offset the costs for Confidential Help for Alcohol and Drugs to provide Prevention / Intervention Services at Weedsport, Cato-Meridian, and Port Byron school districts with counselors working directly with youth in the classroom? Nearly 20% of those turning to Catholic Charities of the Finger Lakes' **Emergency Energy Assistance** program were County North residents. Not all programs collect personal data, but of those that do, we know that 12% of our northern neighbors are turning to a United Way funded program.
