FAST FACTS: COUNTY SOUTH

- Your United Way of Cayuga County has been countywide since August 2, 1948
- 32 of the 36 United Way funded programs have the capacity to be countywide based on who is accessing the service
- Towns that make up County South: Genoa, Ledyard, Locke, Moravia, Niles, Scipio, Sempronius, Springport, Summerhill, & Venice
- Of those turning to a United Way funded program, more than 15% are County South residents

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT: SALVATION ARMY

As a Military Veteran and a member of the Cayuga County 911 dispatch team, supporting my neighbors and ensuring they are safe with access to essential resources is important to me. I am proud to be a part of the United Way because the gifts you and I make go toward programs like the American Red Cross' Services to the **Armed Forces** to support military families during and post service. This program connects military families to counseling services, loans via the military, program referrals, support to access benefits, and much more.

During the last funding cycle, more than 60% of Cayuga County residents turned to a United Way funded program—a number that continues to grow. This year, your United Way is supporting 28 nonprofits through 36 distinct programs addressing Community Resilience, Youth Opportunity, Healthy Communities, and Financial Security.

As a proud aunt, friend, and first responder, I know that the need for reliable and safe childcare is a critical need throughout all regions of Cayuga County. In our rural communities, your gifts support a variety of traditional programs such as the Auburn YMCA's Childcare Center and School Age Child Care in Moravia, Weedsport, Cato, and Port Byron schools; as well as the E. John Gavras Center's Essential Child Care. Summer camps provide alternative care solutions and nearly 270 youth from rural communities in Cayuga County who attended Camp Gregory or Camp Y-Owasco last year.



Understanding the need to support our early childcare and learning centers, Child Care Solutions is piloting their Quality Improvement program here in Cayuga County. This program has been successful in Onondaga County providing small grants and educational opportunities to childcare centers. Childcare is just one area where your United Way gifts provide support. Cayuga Community Health Network's Street Outreach & Advocacy program provides case management

services to individuals who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Did you know that ARISE's Countywide Ramp Program assembled teams of volunteers to build accessibility ramps for homes in Genoa. Locke, and Moravia? Founded by a Millard Fillmore Elementary School teacher, Perform 4 Purpose hosts several concerts, workshops, and camps across all regions of Cayuga County. Of all our neighbors turning to a United Way of Cayuga County funded program or service, 15% are from County South.
