As a Weedsport resident and small business owner, I see the transportation struggles our rural neighbors face. Thanks to United Way funding, **SCAT Van** can transport senior and disabled neighbors to the grocery store, social outings, as well as to and from work. Their services are available countywide with vans based in Cato, Auburn, Union Springs, and Moravia.

During the last funding cycle, more than 60% of Cayuga County residents turned to a United Way funded program—a number that continues to grow. This year, your United Way is supporting 28 nonprofits through 36 distinct programs addressing **Community Resilience**, **Youth Opportunity**, **Healthy Communities**, and **Financial Security**.

Being a mother and small business owner, I understand the importance of reliable and safe childcare to put parents' minds at ease while they're at work. Your gifts support a variety of traditional programs such as the Auburn YMCA's **Childcare Center** and **School Age Child Care**, E. John Gavras Center's Essential Child Care, and Booker T. Washington Community Center's **Before and After School Care** program. Collectively, these programs support more than 1,020 youth. Summer camps provide alternative care solutions and nearly 700 Cayuga County youth who attended **Camp Y-Owasco** or **Camp Gregory** last year.



Understanding the need to support our early childcare and learning centers, Child Care Solutions is piloting their **Quality Improvement** program here in Cayuga County. This program has been successful in Onondaga County providing small grants and educational opportunities to childcare centers. Childcare is just one area where your United Way gift supports the workforce. As part of the **Student United Way** curriculum, high school students share their career aspirations and United Way staff invite guest speakers from those fields to share real life experiences. Did you know that one aspect of Aurora of CNY's **Social Work Services** is to provide job training and placement for those with vision and hearing loss? Since 2012, the United Way's **CA\$H: Free Tax Preparation** program has filed hundreds of tax returns bringing back more than \$500,000 to Cayuga County residents each year. Through childcare, feeding programs, transportation, hygiene items, and job training, 15 United Way funded programs support our workforce.
