- Areas included in our Southern Cayuga Central School District totals: Aurora, Genoa, King Ferry, Poplar Ridge, and Scipio Center while County South also includes Locke, Moravia, and Union Springs totals
- 32 of 36 programs have the capacity to support residents within the Southern Cayuga Central School District should they seek out those supports
- During the last funding cycle, residents in the SCCS District utilized 17 of the 32 programs with countywide accessibility
- Since being established in 2022, the Community Building Mini-Grant program has awarded \$1,000 to the Southern Cayuga Parent Teacher Organization the past two years to support the Roller-Skating Clinic held at the school
- The Community Building Mini-Grants have also supported the King Ferry Food Pantry to purchase soft foods and other special dietary needs from the SCCS District Community
- The King Ferry Food Pantry has been a recipient of the annual Countywide Personal Care Drive since 2017 receiving hygiene items such as soaps, toothbrushes, lotions, toilet paper, laundry detergent, feminine hygiene items, and much more
- Of our County South neighbors turning to the American Red Cross for Emergency
 Disaster Relief or Services to the Armed Forces, 62% live within the SCCS District
- ARISE built a ramp for a Genoa resident last year
- Auburn Music Boosters and Perform 4 Purpose support youth and their musical talents in the SCCS District community—nearly 40% of County South youth participating in Perform 4 Purpose come from the SCCS District
- Auburn YMCA-WEIU's mentorship program, Y-Pals, supported 52 youth within the SCCS District
- SCCS District youth participated in Auburn YMCA-WEIU's Camp Y-Owasco and were enrolled in their Preschool / Childcare Center

- Camp Gregory, based along Cayuga Lake in Aurora, welcomed more than 130 youth to their summer camp last season—74% of youth were from SCCS District
- Catholic Charities of the Finger Lakes helped neighbors in the SCCS District community keep their utilities on last year
- Of County South neighbors turning to Cayuga Counseling Services' Clinic and SAVAR programs, 27% are from the SCCS District community
- During the last funding cycle, SCCS District community members relied on Confidential Help for Alcohol & Drugs' Outpatient Clinic for mental health support
- SCCS District families enrolled youth into the E. John Gavras Center's Essential Childcare Program
- Youth from SCCS District community participated in both the Girl Scouts of NYPENN Pathways and Scouting America: Longhouse Council programs
- Literacy Volunteers of Cayuga County hosts an English as a Second Language program in Genoa
- Of County South neighbors utilizing Transportation of Cayuga County's SCAT VAN program, 18% live within the SCCS District.
