COMMUNITY BUILDING MINI-GRANT

In July 2022, your United Way launched the Community Building Mini-Grant. This grant was created to support unexpected opportunities, existing programs and services, and advances in professional development. Unique to our annual funding cycle, these mini-grants are accepted on a rolling basis, require a shorter application, and are open to all nonprofits in Cayuga County, and to nonprofits who serve Cayuga County residents. Community Building Mini-Grants directly address areas of children and youth achieving their potential through education and healthy family lives, helping families and individuals become financially stable and self-sufficient, the improvement of physical and mental wellness of people of all ages, and the delivery of safety net resources or basic needs.

STUDENT UNITED WAY

Student United Way is a campus-based club led by and for students, with support from its local United Way and guidance from a campus advisor. Student United Ways exist on college and high school campuses around the world. Through Student United Way, our youth leaders gain valuable leadership skills, knowledge about critical community issues and a better understanding of how they can advance the common good. In August 2022, your United Way partnered with the Auburn High School and community advisors to start a Student United Way program. As we work on this project and develop a successful model, we hope to bring Student United Way to districts throughout the county.
